The Taft Foundation Athletic Association will hold registration for the 2024-2025 basketball season!

THURSDAY, SEPT. 19, 2024

From 6-8 PM

BASKETBALL REGISTRATION: Will stay open till the end of school day September 26th. Please have all your paperwork & money turned in that day. All monies must be turned in to allow time to get uniforms, games, tourney fees to be set.

For all **THIRD, FOURTH, FIFTH and SIXTH GRADE** boys and girls!

Sports physicals are required for all athletes and forms can be obtained at your doctor's office.

They must be turned into the school nurse prior to your child practicing. If No physical form is turned in for your child(ren) they can NOT participate in ANY team activities.

Players in 4th – 6th grades will receive a uniform of a reversible jersey and shorts. We will take uniform orders at registration for any player who needs a new uniform. The cost for a complete uniform is \$55. Cash or check made to (**Taft Foundation**). Sample pieces will be available to try on at registration. A new jersey is \$35 and new shorts are \$20 if you don't need a complete set.

Third grade players will order a T-shirt for \$15. Black short will be worn in a game.

The Sports Fee \$120 (cash or check made payable to **Taft Foundation**). Money is used for tournament entry fees and game referee fees.

We are also collecting a \$150 volunteer deposit checks (separate check made payable to **Taft Foundation**). The volunteer fee is \$150 per family. The volunteer deposit will be returned once **FIVE** hours of volunteer time is completed during the 78th annual Taft Tournament to be held the first 2 weekends in January 2025. If you choose not to volunteer at the tournament, we will deposit your check to cover costs to run tournament w/fill ins.

All fees must be paid before a player will be allowed to participate. You must pay in cash or check; no ePay allowed. No uniforms will be ordered unless they are paid for.
